Dear Parishioners,

I hope you all had a very happy and blessed Independence Day weekend. It was very hot, and, of course as we all know, it's been hot all week. I want to thank you for the warm welcome, both literally and figuratively, given to Father Donald Heet, OSFS, last weekend. There are still envelopes for the special collection for the missions on the table in the lobby of church. Thank you for your generosity.

Recently, all the priests and deacons of the Archdiocese received resources for the Second Annual World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly that will take place the weekend of July 23 and 24. I will have more information next week, but in the meantime, keep in mind, please, that this year the "Apostolic Penitentiary" (the office that administers indulgences, not a prison!) has granted a plenary indulgence to all the elderly who participate in the world day liturgies, and to all who, in the days immediately preceding or following the World Day, visit an elderly person who is alone. Pope Francis wrote that visiting an elderly person is "a work of mercy in our time!"

Coordinator of Religious Education: With the recent retirement of Mrs. Cindy Meirink as Pastoral Associate and head of our PSR program, I have asked **Sister Annette Marie Kaba, OSF**, a Franciscan Sister of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, to take over the PSR program. Sister has been a Director of Religious Education, a Pastoral Associate, a Principal of two grade schools, a Grade School Teacher, and an Assistant Minister on the Leadership Team of her order in her over 50 years as a nun. She has a BA in American Studies, an MA in Religious Studies, and 21 hours in School Administration courses. Sister will be part-time in her role in leading our Parish School of Religion and coordinating the Sacramental Preparation programs for our young people. She will be "in and out" over the next few weeks. Please welcome her if you run into her! Thank you.
