

DECREE

As Saint Monica Parish in Creve Coeur, Missouri, has received in an amalgamation the former territory of Saint John Bosco Parish in Maryland Heights, Missouri, and Saint Richard Parish in Creve Coeur, Missouri, and in accordance with canons 121, 515, and 518 of the Code of Canon Law and having consulted the Presbyteral Council, I hereby alter the territorial boundaries of Saint Monica Parish.

The reason for this alteration is to attend to the pastoral needs of the faithful who have until now lived in the parish boundaries of Saint John Bosco Parish and Saint Richard Parish.

I promulgate the territorial boundaries of Saint Monica Parish to be as follows:

Starting at Olive Boulevard and Spoede Road;

South on Spoede Road (west side) to Mission Hills Court;

West from this intersection on an imaginary line to Graeser Road, just south of Faron Hill Road and Graeser Lane;

South on Graeser Road (west side) to Ladue Road;

West on Ladue Road (north side) to a point between Ladue Grove Lane and Ambleside Lane;

North on an imaginary line between Falling Leaves Court and Falaise Drive to Hibler Road;

West on Hibler Road (north side) to Mason Road;

North on Mason Road (east side) to Olive Boulevard;

West on Olive Boulevard (north side) to Fee Fee Road;

North on Fee Fee Road (east side) to a point just south of Seven Pines Drive at the southern boundary of Parkway North High School;

West from this point on an imaginary line (north of Banyon Town Road) to the intersection of Creve Coeur Mill Road and Waterworks Road;

West on Waterworks Road to River Valley Drive;

West on River Valley Drive to Hog Hollow Road and from that intersection on the extension of River Valley Drive to the Missouri River;

North along the Missouri River to the northwestern extension of River Valley Drive and River Valley Drive;

East on River Valley Drive (south side) to the Maryland Heights Expressway (Highway 141);

North and east on the Maryland Heights Expressway (Highway 141) to Creve Coeur Mill Road;

Southeast on Creve Coeur Mill Road extended to the southeast to end of Rule Avenue;

Southeast on Rule Avenue (west side) to Ameling Road;

East on Ameling Road (south side) to Pheasant Run Drive;

South on Pheasant Run Drive (west side) to Dorsett Road;

East on Dorsett Road (south side) to Interstate 270;

South on Interstate 270 to Page Avenue;

Northeast from that intersection on an imaginary line to the intersection of Fee Fee Road and Westport Plaza Drive;

Northeast from that intersection on Fee Fee Road (south side) and the extension of Fee Fee Road to the railroad tracks just south of Dorsett Road;

Southeast on the railroad tracks to Lindbergh Boulevard;

South on Lindbergh Boulevard (west side) to Baur Boulevard;

East on Baur Boulevard (south side) to Ashby Road;

North on Ashby Road (east side) to Page Avenue;

East on Page Avenue (south side) to Price Road;

South on Price Road and its southwest extension continuing on Price Road (west side) to Olive Boulevard;

West on Olive Boulevard (north side) to Spoede Road.

All Catholics having domicile within the above-described territory are members of Saint Monica Parish and, as such, benefit from the pastoral care of the Reverend Pastor of the Parish.

This Decree is effective August 1, 2023. Its official notification is its publication on the website of the Archdiocese of Saint Louis on May 28, 2023.

I direct that the Pastor of Saint Monica Parish announce at all Masses on the weekend of May 27-28, 2023, that this Decree has been published on the website of the Archdiocese of Saint Louis (allthingsnew.archstl.org). I ask the Pastor and the faithful of Saint Monica Parish to make every effort to welcome the former members of Saint John Bosco Parish and Saint Richard Parish.


Any member of Saint Monica Parish who claims to have been aggrieved by this Decree has the right to seek its revocation or emendation (canon 1734). This request must be made in writing and postmarked no later than June 12, 2023, to the Most Reverend Archbishop of Saint Louis, Cardinal Rigali Center, 20 Archbishop May Drive, Saint Louis, Missouri 63119.

Anything to the contrary notwithstanding.
